## HOW THE PROGRAM WORKS

The Drive to the Future Program runs for at least twelve months. Activities include:

### 1 LEARNER'S PERMIT

Passing eyesight and computerised theory test.

### 2 LEARNING TO DRIVE

Taking driving lessons and logging hours.

### 3 HAZARD PERCEPTION TEST

Sitting the Hazard Perception Test after six months of holding a learner's permit.

### 4 GAINING DRIVING EXPERIENCE

Logging at least 50 hours of supervised driving, including five hours at night.

### 5 DRIVING TEST

Sitting the practical driving assessment.

### 6 PROVISIONAL DRIVER'S LICENCE

Provisional driver's licence issued for the first two years.

## BENEFITS FOR ALL

**By providing quality instruction and guidance to novice drivers, the program aims to improve overall community safety.**

In many Western Australian remote and regional towns like Broome, the only way to get to work or social events is by car. So being able to drive safely is crucial.

Unfortunately, getting a licence to drive is an expensive process, often out of reach for many young people. Thus, affecting their ability to gain employment and take part in social activities. Drive to the Future offers the support many young people need in Broome.

## ADDITIONAL SUPPORT

Often many young people need extra support. Through Drive to the Future young people will gain:

- ✓ **Support to obtain necessary identification documents** such as Birth Certificate or Medicare cards
- ✓ **Literacy, numeracy and computer skills** support
- ✓ **Resume and job application** support
- ✓ **Licensing enrolment** support
- ✓ **Small group** or one on one theory practice
- ✓ **Computer lab/room:** access to the practice Learners test and Hazard Perception Test practice
