Carnarvon PCYC is a not-for-profit organisation that works in close partnership with local WA Police, schools and community service groups to provide programs that decrease boredom and divert young people away from anti-social behaviour.

Our 'SafeSPACE' programs provide at-risk youth aged 8-18yr with a safe alternative to hanging out in the streets with a place to access support, meet with friends and engage in positive activities.

During School Holiday periods Carnarvon PCYC provides structured activities for young people, including art & craft, cooking, movies, and indoor sports such as basketball, table tennis, badminton and soccer.

Carnarvon PCYC also provides inclusive and affordable recreational activities for all members of the community, including a fitness centre, group fitness classes, and seasonal social competitions of badminton, indoor cricket and volleyball.
